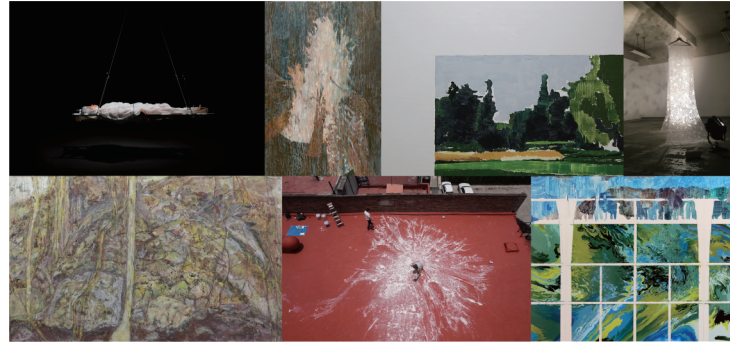


「ASK-7 Artists Exhibition」

AOO is pleased to present an exhibition “ASK-7 Artists Exhibition” .

“A.S.K (Atelier Share Kyoto)” is share studios in Kyoto, which goes back twenty-two years to "Atelier Nagaya in Saikyo". In 1996, "Atelier Nagaya in Saikyo" renovated two Nagayas of craftsmen located next to Yuzen dyeing Factory, and started to lent them as share studios for artists. At that time, the idea of "sharing" was not yet common as today.

After that, “A.S.K” and "Kyoto ceramic art studio - tochin" (share studio for ceramics) successively joined to it in 2010 and in 2012, and nowadays “A.S.K” consists of three share studio buildings. Since then, regardless of lending-period, age and nationality, more than 100 artists have been based in “A.S.K” .

"A.S.K" also seeks the way to support artists, sponsoring "KYOTO ART HOSTEL Kumagusuku" in 2015. In the spring of 2018, the artists in “A.S.K” showed a new movement of voluntarily launching an Artist Run Gallery named "Alt Space Post".

At this time, AOO hold a group exhibition “A.S.K : 7 Artists Exhibition” by the artists in “A. S. K” with different academic backgrounds, ages and nationalities.

With this exhibition, you can think of “Le Bateau-Lavoir” for Picasso and Modigliani, “La Ruche” for Chagall and Les Gets, or “Ikebukuro Montparnasse” for Aimitsu and Matsumoto Shunsuke. AOO is pleased to show a cross-section of share studios with promising contemporary artists. We do hope you will be able to have a look.
